**SPILLAGE MEASURES**

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**FIRST AID MEASURES**

<b>Swallowed</b>	Take victim immediately to hospital. Do NOT induce vomiting. ANTIDOTE is vitamin K1 – to be administered by a medical or veterinarian professional
<b>Eyes</b>	Rinse immediately with plenty of water, also under the eyelids, for at least 15 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Get medical attention if irritation develops and persists.
<b>Skin</b>	Take off all contaminated clothing immediately. Wash off immediately with plenty of water. If skin irritation persists, call a physician. Wash contaminated clothing before re-use.
<b>Inhaled</b>	Move the victim to fresh air. If breathing is irregular or stopped, administer artificial respiration. Keep patient warm and at rest. Call a physician or poison control centre immediately. Unlikely to present an inhalation hazard as the product is supplied as a paste
